



Portland International Airport

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Portland International Airport is the largest airport in the state of Oregon, accounting for 90% of passenger travel of the state. It is located on the south side of the Columbia River, six miles by air and twelve miles by highway northeast of downtown Portland.

Condé Nast Traveler magazine has named PDX as the best U.S. airport – for the second year in a row. PDX received the top overall score from international business travelers who rated U.S. airports based on several criteria including location/access, ease of connections, customs/baggage, food/shops/amenities, comfort/design, and perceived safety/security.

Plus, there's *free* Wi-Fi throughout the airport!

Portland International Airport offers non-stop commercial air service to 16 of the 17 most populated US Metropolitan Statistical Areas. plus direct international flights to Canada, Mexico, Japan, Germany, Singapore, and The Netherlands. This airport is an ideal venue for reaching the modern U.S. business traveler, offering the best in airport service and amenities.
