Norman Y. Mineta San José International Airport sits in the heart of Silicon Valley and services the San Francisco Bay Area, the fifth largest Designated Market Area (DMA) in the United States.

This airport is located in the center of the world's number one technology center. The city of San José is home to 50% of Silicon Valley's top networking, telecommunications and semiconductor firms. Every year more than eight million tech business travelers come to do business in this wired Mecca, and they come through San José International Airport.

San José International Airport offers non-stop service to 24 domestic destinations as well as multiple daily flights to Mexico, Hawaii and Japan. This airport is also the premier venue to reach the west coast U.S. business traveler, offering frequent air service along the West Coast corridor.
